Vicar's Voice You're Grounded!!...that's a good thing!

Hello Friends, In your life, what is it that anchors you? To whom do you look for stability and strength? What grounds you? This is an important theme which I would like to mull over this week.

As we mature, we come to realize the importance of groundedness. To **ground** is "to place on a foundation; fix firmly; settle or establish." (Dictionary.com). As we look through the Scriptures, we see that it is God's design that we be grounded. In Genesis 1:9 as God is creating everything, one of the most important things that God does was to separate the waters from the land -thus creating solid ground for people. In Psalm 40, the Psalmist proclaims that, after "lifting him out of the slimy pit, he puts his feet on a rock, giving him a firm place to stand." (verses 1-3).

In *the Revelation to John*, John sees a vision of the re-ordered world for the faithful. Chapter 21:1, reads:" Then I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away, and *there was no longer any sea."* In the bible, "the sea" is synonymous with chaos. So, the renewed creation is a place where chaos is obliterated. "The Rock," Who is Christ, meets us and grounds us in His love.

Jesus came to this world to engage people and bring healing. He came to ground us. "For no one can lay a foundation other than the one already laid, which is Jesus Christ." (1 Cor 3:11). In the Gospels, time and time again, Jesus brings order -quenching chaotic situations. He heals a woman who had known only suffering and pain for 38 years. He restores a demon-possessed man to spiritual health. He re-establishes Peter - transforming him. No longer a deny-er, but now "the rock upon which I will build my church!

We live in a chaotic world. Our lives are impacted by and often reflect this chaos. How grounded are you? Do you hear Jesus' voice amid the chaos? Do you know what to listen for? As the season of Advent nears, my prayer is that it be filled with reflection and contemplation. I invite you to not simply remember Jesus who grounds us but also to draw strength and direction from Him. This great hymn is of comfort and encouragement...

When darkness veils His lovely face,
I rest on His unchanging grace;
In every high and stormy gale,
My anchor holds within the veil.

On Christ, the solid Rock, I stand;
All other ground is sinking sand,
