Encouragement...we all need it!

This past week, we observed St Barnabas' Day. Barnabas, also known as "Joseph," is best known for his gift of encouragement -which he shared liberally!

Who was Barnabas? He was an Apostle and a pillar of the 1st Century Church. Barnabas (which means "son of encouragement"), was well beloved among the Apostles. He saw the best in others and, through his giftedness, helped others to grow into maturity in Christ. To illustrate, he influenced a "young" Christian convert named Paul.

Later in his ministry, Barnabas took John Mark under his wing. John Mark, at that time, was a young, aspiring leader -whom Paul initially had no time for. Eventually, Paul recognized John Mark's growth - as Paul sent for him when Paul was in prison. In 2 Timothy 4:11, Paul writes: "...bring John Mark because he is useful in my ministry." Because Barnabas had encouraged and worked with John Mark, he was now more effective and useful to Paul.

While we know that we are living in increasingly difficult times. A terse or sharp word can really affect us. ALL of us need encouragement. We all are blessed by the "Barnabas" in our lives.

The Scriptures are full of encouraging words for us all. I leave these 2 verses with you: 1 Thessalonians 5:11 "Therefore encourage one another and build each other up..." Also, Romans 15:5: "May the God who gives endurance and encouragement give you the same attitude of mind toward each other that Christ Jesus had."

As followers of Jesus, we have the marvelous opportunity in our everyday life, to offer an encouraging and supportive word which will bring light and life to others. This is what "kingdom living" is about.

Jesus Christ is Risen Indeed! Halleluiah!
